The Woodside Road Residents' Group of Tenterfield, northern New South Wales have no broadband access and no opportunity to get broadband because our copper delivery system is not able to handle the ADSL technology.

Rural areas like ours are starting to seriously slip behind in educational opportunities and business growth opportunities.

As modern health moves on to broadband, this to is denied to us.

We need a further roll out of the mobile tower system, so that the following can occur:

(a) we can receive and send mobile telephone calls, and

(b) so that we can eventually be able to access wireless broadband technology.

We currently have no mobile phone service and no broadband service. We still have neighbours with no landline service!

We request a continuation of the mobile phone tower rollout system so that our health, education and commercial welfare can improve.
